

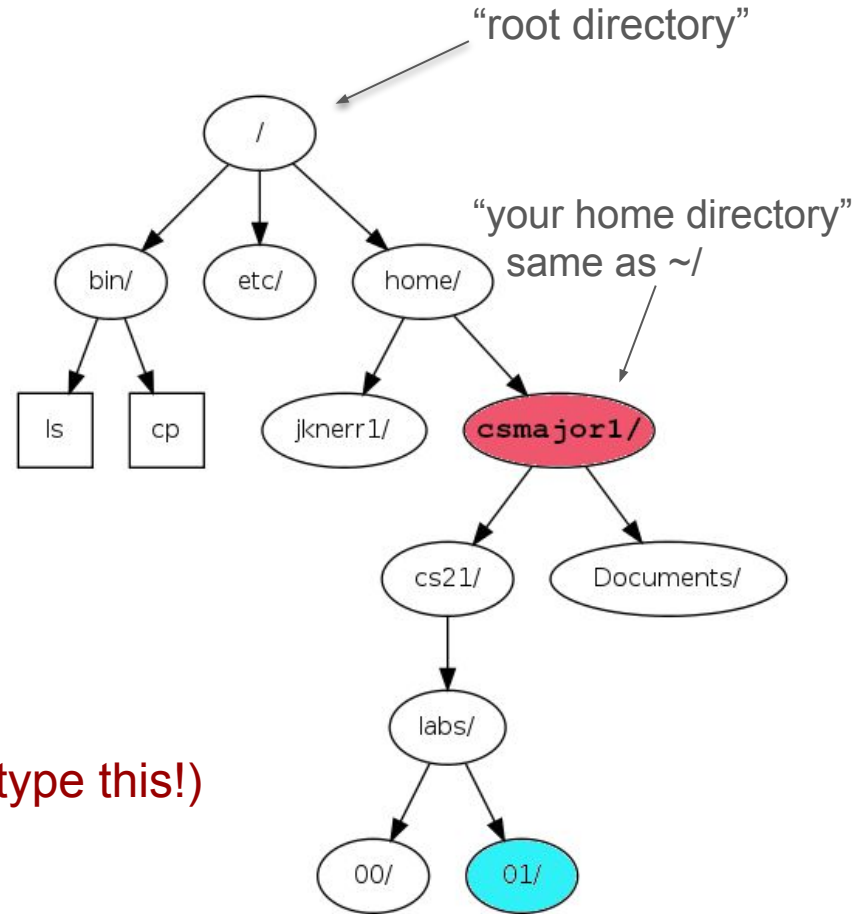
Basic Navigation Commands

- `$ pwd`
- `$ cd <directory>`
- `$ ls [file or directory]`
- `$ cat <file>`
- `$ mv <source> <destination>`
- `$ cp <source> <destination>`
- `$ rm <file or directory>`
- `$ mkdir <directory name>`


\$ indicates command prompt (do not type this!)

<...> = necessary input

[...] = optional input



Handy Terminal Shortcuts

- Tab complete!!
- Ctrl+a - jump to start of command
- Ctrl+e - jump to end of command
-  - scroll through command history
- Ctrl+r - search command history
- \$ history - print command history
- Ctrl+l - refresh the terminal – same as typing “clear”
